Paul wrote

1 Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the value of circumcision? 2 Much in every way. To begin with, **the Jews were entrusted with the oracles of God.**" Romans 3:1-2

"18 **do not be arrogant** toward the natural branches. If you are [in Christ], remember it is not you who support the root, but the root that

supports you. 19 Then you will say, "Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in." 20 That is true. They were broken off because of their unbelief, but you stand fast through faith. **So do not become proud, but fear.**" 21 For if God did not spare the natural branches, neither will he spare you. 22 Note then the kindness and the severity of God: severity toward those who have fallen, but God's kindness to you, provided you continue in his kindness. Otherwise you too will be cut off. 23 And even they, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God has the power to graft them in again. 24 For if you [being gentiles] were cut from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and grafted, contrary to nature, into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, the natural branches, be grafted back into their own olive tree. 25 Lest you be wise in your own sight, I do not want you to be unaware of this mystery, brothers: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. 26 And in this way all Israel will be saved, as it is written

"The Deliverer will come from Zion,
he will banish ungodliness from Jacob";
27 "and this will be my covenant with them
when I take away their sins."

28 As regards the gospel, they are enemies for your sake. **But as regards election, they are beloved for the sake of their forefathers.** 29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. 30 For just as you were at one time disobedient to God but now have received mercy because of their disobedience, 31 so they too have now been disobedient in order that by the mercy shown to you they also may now receive mercy. 32 For God has consigned all to disobedience, that he may have mercy on all. Romans 11:18-32

Yeshua (Jesus) said

"believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father. 22 You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, **for salvation is from the Jews.** 23 But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. 24 God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth." john 4:21-24

The prophet Isaiah wrote,

and with his wounds we are healed.
6 All we like sheep have gone astray;

The prophet Daniel wrote
13"I saw in the night visions,
and behold, with the clouds of heaven
there came one like a son of man,
and he came to the Ancient of Days
and was presented before him.
14 And to him was given dominion
and glory and a kingdom,
that all peoples, nations, and languages
should serve him;
his dominion is an everlasting dominion,
which shall not pass away,
and his kingdom one
that shall not be destroyed.

Yeshua (Jesus) responded when asked
"...Again the high priest asked him, "**Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?**" 62And
Yeshua (Jesus) said, "**I am, and you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand**
of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven." mark 14:61-62

Written in the gospels
"37 And over his head they put the charge against him, which read, "This is Yeshua (Jesus),
the King of the Jews." Matt 27:37

Conclusion

In 1967 when Israel's enemies banned against her in **the 6-day war, the Lord used it to bring about the reclamation of Jerusalem.**

We pray that Adonai's word will not fail (praise Him it never does), that good will come out of these evil attacks, perhaps **a rebuilding of your temple and the expulsion of your enemies.**

As it is written by prophet Isaiah
14The sons of those who afflicted you
shall come bending low to you,
and all who despised you
shall bow down at your feet;
they shall call you the City of the Lord,
the Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

15 Whereas you have been forsaken and hated,
with no one passing through,
I will make you majestic forever,
a joy from age to age.

16 You shall suck the milk of nations;
you shall nurse at the breast of kings;
and you shall know that I, the Lord, am your Savior
and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.

17 Instead of bronze I will bring gold,
and instead of iron I will bring silver;
instead of wood, bronze,
instead of stones, iron.
I will make your overseers peace
and your taskmasters righteousness.

18 Violence shall no more be heard in your land,
devastation or destruction within your borders;
you shall call your walls Salvation,
and your gates Praise.

19 The sun shall be no more
your light by day,
nor for brightness shall the moon
give you light;
but the Lord will be your everlasting light,
and your God will be your glory.

20 Your sun shall no more go down,
nor your moon withdraw itself;
for the Lord will be your everlasting light,
and your days of mourning shall be ended.

21 Your people shall all be righteous;
they shall possess the land forever,
the branch of my planting, the work of my hands,
that I might be glorified.

22 The least one shall become a clan,
and the smallest one a mighty nation;
I am the Lord;
in its time I will hasten it.

Isaiah 60:14-22
